3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution **no later than 4 weeks** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

*This inter-institutional agreement is valid **until 2020** However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year will be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.*



Housing: The receiving institution will guide incoming mobile participants in finding accommodation, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.
