- Orientation day organized with all international students to provide information about organization and choice of courses, workshops, administrative issues, French courses for foreign students.
- French courses for foreign students offered
- At the end of the Winter semester, a round-table gathering all the exchange students (incoming, before their departure /outgoing, when they are back) is organized to share information and viewpoints on their international mobility experience. An exhibition is organized for the open-doors of the school.

For the implementation of STA/STT-mobilities, a letter of invitation – issued by an UP contact person – is required. STA/STT mobility's purpose / teaching contents must have been discussed and defined by both teaching teams before the letter of invitation can be issued, so that the erasmus teaching/formation contract can be filled with both erasmus offices.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. The agreement will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate. This should be done in writing, and a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. The agreement can be cancelled activities can be added to it, and changes in mobility data can be made annually provided they are communicated before January 1.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
