RO GALATIO1:

Students: The sending institution should send a nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) to the International Relations Office/Erasmus (bianca.chiosa@ugal.ro) prior to the nomination deadline. An invitation will be released upon home university request.

Students must arrive at least 3 days before the academic year/semester starts, but not during the weekends. Students in Bachelor and Master study programs are allowed to attend courses of maximum 63 credits/academic year and 33 credits/semester.

Staff: Teaching and non-teaching staff should send (<u>dan.scarpete@ugal.ro</u>) their Teaching or Training Programme prior to their arrival at the University "Dunarea de Jos" of Galati. An invitation will be released upon staff request. **Disabled Students and Staff** are welcome.

Within 15 days after their arrival, they need to register within Immigration Office, providing a proof of sufficient funding and health insurance coverage. Students will be assisted to prepare their registration in order to get their residence permit.
