- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has
  finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education
  guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

**BG SVISHT002** – Marks at the D. A. Tsenov Academy of Economics are awarded on a scale of 2-6 (6 being the highest). This corresponds to grades F-A. If the grade is between 2.00 and 2.49, the student cannot sit the final exam. A certain number of credits are awarded for each examination. "Credit" in the ECTS context represents a unit of work that the student must complete in connection with his/her education in a specific course in order to successfully complete a semester or an academic year. Most frequently, credits represent the time spent by the student for the preparation of a given course, attendance at lectures and self-study assignments.
