Additional requirements

PL CZESTOC01:

The Learning Agreement should be negotiated and agreed on by three sides – sending institution, receiving institution and the student - before student's arrival.

At the CUT the faculty's dean/vice-dean + both coordinators (faculty and institutional) will sign it.

Letter of Acceptance will be given by CUT not earlier than the Learning Agreement (students) or Mobility Agreement (staff) will be established.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement shall remain in force until the end of the Programme (2020/21). In case of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2014 will only take effect as of 1 September 2014+1. "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
