Academic achievement is graded under two systems: A-B-C-D-E-F and Pass-Fail system. Regular examinations (*eksam* in Estonian) use a scale ranging from A (highest) to F (fail). The scale is defined as follows:

Α	excellent	outstanding performance	91-100%
В	very good	outstanding performance with some errors	81-90%
С	good	generally sound work with a number of notable errors	71-80%
D	Satisfac- tory	fair but with significant shortcomings	61-70%
E	poor	some knowledge of the subject but severe shortcomings	51-60%
F	fail	unsatisfactory knowledge	0-50%

Prelims or Pass-Fail examinations (arvestus in Estonian) award the student either a pass or a fail.
