2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [6] weeks after the application deadline
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

*[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]*

*The grading scheme in Germany usually comprises five levels (with numerical equivalents; intermediate grades may be given):*

„Sehr Gut“ (1) = Very good

„Gut“ (2)= Good



- „Befriedigend“ (3) = Satisfactory
- „Ausreichend“ (4) = Sufficient
- „Mangelhaft“ (5) = Non-sufficient/fail

Verbal designations of grades may vary in some cases and for doctoral degrees.

In addition, Münster University of Applied Sciences uses the ECTS grading scheme, which operates with the levels A (best 10%), B (next 25%), C (next 30%), D (next 25%) and E (next 10%), only in case of the final grade of the entire degree programme.


