#### F VALENCIO1:

Students who are candidate to incoming Erasmus+ mobility will be preselected by their home institution and nominated in advance by Email to <a href="mailto:erasmus@uphf.fr">erasmus@uphf.fr</a>. The nomination will include following data of the candidate: Name, first name, nationality, birth date, gender, subject area of studies, study level, language of tuition, start date of planned mobility, duration of planned mobility, Email address.

The inbound Erasmus+ student will send the following documents: proposed learning agreement for studies including language competence level, certificate of registration of home institution and transcript of records of current higher education studies translated into English or French, the copy of current passport and birth certificate translated into French if a French student visa is needed, UPHF application form to be completed on:

The faculty concerned at UPHF will select the student based on the following criteria: language competence, higher education records, quality of learning agreement namely relevance between planned programme and the degree aimed at home institution. The UPHF is not able to accept incoming Erasmus+ students from subject areas not covered by the bilateral agreement.

Services offered in terms of welcome and integration of incoming Erasmus+ students are detailed in the International Student Welcome Guide.

The UPHF has adapted its facilities in order to allow access to people with disabilities. - 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

The marking scale in France goes from 0 to 20. 0 being the lowest mark, 20 being the highest. 10 is the average mark which in most cases is the lowest mark required to obtain ECTS credits. The ECTS system is used. The transcript of records provided by the International Relations Office (PRI UPHF) will indicate the ECTS grading scale for each French mark delivered in order to facilitate the transfer of credits.
