* As most of the courses are carried out in Greek, it is desired that the students speak and write in Greek. However the Department accepts students whose English knowledge is assessed to the B2 European Level, because the Department offers the alternative possibility to the Erasmus students of getting the necessary credits by either (i) taking exams following private teaching sessions with the instructors, (ii) writing an essay-paper in English, (iii) implementing a small project, and (iv) combinations of the above, or selecting from a variety of courses which are taught exclusively in the English language during the academic year, if a minimum number of students is registered for the specific course.

TR ISTANBU07 will send its decision within 4 weeks.

G PIREAS 01: Nominated students receive by e-mail their Application Form and Learning Agreement that they have to complete within the deadline above. Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within no later than 6 weeks. Changes to Original Learning Agreement can only be made by students during the first 2 weeks after the start of classes. Students must respect this deadline.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement

The present agreement is valid for a period mentioned above. This agreement may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both Universities. It may be renewed on the same terms, or on such terms as may be agreed by the two institutions.

This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Universities upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than one year before the termination date, without prejudice to the activities under way. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
