Students and staff with disabilities may be accepted upon prior confirmation. Staff mobility projects for teaching are subject to the acceptance of the relative Department.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should



normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

#### 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 November 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
