



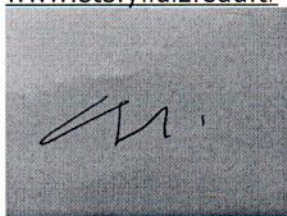
# Erasmus+ Programme

## D. Additional requirements

### Partner institution: I ROMA30

Selection criteria for both incoming and outgoing students:

- Compatibility of courses and subjects to be attended
- Music skills and knowledge (to be proved by means of audio/video supports)
- Language skills (B1 Italian, B2 English)
- Available places

Students and staff with disabilities may be accepted upon prior confirmation.

Staff mobility projects for teaching are subject to the acceptance of the relative Department.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within **6** weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **5** weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should*



*normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*

#### 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 November 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
