TERMINATION CLAUSES OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement is valid for the duration indicated above and may be updated or terminated by mutual agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 01st **June of the year preceding the a.y. in which the Erasmus mobility will be spent** (for example 1st June 2014 for an inter-institutional agreement valid for a.y. 2015/2016). Only takes effect at the beginning of the following Erasmus a.y. (i.e. 1st June 20XX+1). "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
