- missing classes = no entry to exams session (unless a notice on serious reason of absence is sent to the academic coordinator at particular faculty and to International Mobility Office)

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks for YTU and [5] weeks for SUT, after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

additionally for PL GLIWICE01:

In case of re-exams session, transcript of records may be issued and sent to students home institution in parts or in one after the closing dates of completing particular semesters, i.e.:

Winter Semester (WS) – end of February Summer Semester (SS) – end of September

4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that

a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
