This inter-institutional agreement will come into effect only if both institutions are holders of a valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education and they commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.
