- •Students or staff with disabilities are requested to inform of their needs and support needed at application stage, in order to guarantee that their needs and requirements can be addressed and the right support assured prior to their arrival. TU- Sofia could welcome students and staff with disabilities, only according to prior approval of each separate case.
- •Incoming international staff members should apply for visits to the departmental coordinators of the respective faculty with copy sent to the Incoming Student Mobility Office k.ivanova@tu-sofia.bg of the Technical University of Sofia.
- •In case of additional requirements in regard to academic, organizational or other aspects (e. g. students with special needs) please contact the Student Mobility Office k.ivanova@tu-sofia.bg •Incoming Exchange Students are required to agree on the duration and kind of studies (study courses or project work) with the faculty (agreement coordinator) prior arrival at TU Sofia.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
