DIE STADT

THE CITY


DIE UNIVERSITÄT

Die Justus-Liebig-Universität Gießen (JLU) ist eine moderne Hochschule mit über 400-jähriger Geschichte. Important information on visa application and health insurance

Application documents:

First step to take is your Online Application. It is very important to send your application documents in due time to JLÜ Giessen. For your **visa** you require a **Confirmation of Acceptance**, which we can only issue after having processed your documents entirely. In order to receive your Confirmation of Acceptance in time to get your VISA, please send your completed documents as soon as possible.

Visa:

You have to apply for a student **visa** as a non-EU citizen– the status of your visa cannot be changed in Germany. A tourist visa is unfortunately not sufficient. This applies to anybody, who is not citizen of an EU country and can present a corresponding passport (e.g. incoming students from Turkey).

Students with a non-EU citizenship studying in an EU-country with a student residence permit fall under a specific guideline, called REST. If this applies to you, please get in touch with us as soon as possible.

The current amount of a required proof of subsistence is 934€ per month starting 1st of January 2023. The total amount needed will be the number of month times 934€.

Health insurance:

For your period of stay in Germany, you should definitely contract a German statutory health insurance.

Please also check our [Website](#) for further information. Most private health insurances do not cover all medical treatments in Germany so that you would have to pay these high costs yourself. That is why we recommend contracting a German statutory health insurance for students in Germany right after your arrival (and cancelling e.g. your Turkish insurance in order not to have double insurance costs). Remember, medical treatment in Germany is comparatively expensive when you are not sufficiently insured. You might also wish to get an insurance providing for the transport home (often offered by automobile associations) in case of serious illness. These insurances are usually quite inexpensive. We also recommend a travel insurance before your arrival, so you are safe and insured while contracting a German insurance. When enrolling as a student at JLÜ, your confirmation of insurance is obligatory.

In case you have a **European Health Insurance Card**, this is a sufficient proof of Health Insurance. You will get information on how to provide your Confirmation of Insurance to JLÜ at a later point.

Turkish students can also get a Confirmation of Insurance through the A/T 11. In case of questions, let us know.

Accommodation:

Our exchange students usually stay in one of our halls of residence. A room is guaranteed to all our exchange students for their entire period of stay if the application deadline is met. Alternatively, we publish offers for private rooms from outgoing students of JLU for incoming exchange students on www.uni-giessen.de/acc.

Orientation Week for International Students:

During the orientation week our mentors will give exchange students information on their studies in Giessen and inform them about all important dates which should not be missed. The orientation week usually starts two weeks before the start of lectures in the winter semester and one week before the start of lectures in the summer semester. The enrolment will take place online. Students will receive an email from the registrar's office with further information.

German Language Courses:

We offer evening classes in German (free of charge) during the semester. Before each winter semester, exchange students can attend our International Summer Course, before each summer semester our International Spring Course. Both courses include intensive German Language Courses, excursions, workshops, and much more. For the International Summer Course exchange students pay a reduced fee and can gain 4 ECTS. For the International Spring Course exchange students pay a reduced fee and can gain 3 ECTS. Please register online. For registration and more information please see:

Language Requirements:

There are no general language requirements for exchange students. Some departments require proof of certain English or German language skills. We strongly recommend German language skills of at least B1 level to be able to follow classes and to communicate in everyday life! Please ask our exchange/departmental coordinators (see above) for required German language skills in advance!

Average Living Expenses:

Expect approx. € 934 per month plus a (re)registration fee of around € 270,- for our student ID card which includes the "semesterticket" (free public transport within Hesse) and a contribution to the students' union in order to profit from cheaper prices in student restaurants, halls of residence, etc. The (re)registration fee has to be paid at the beginning of each semester (details are indicated in the letter of acceptance):
