Application to our Exchange Programme:

- 1) The students contact the outgoing student advisor at their home institution in order to make arrangements for their stay at HSB in Bremen.
- 2) The coordinators at the home institutions and HSB inform the applicants about the application details.
- 3) The coordinators at the home institutions send a list with the names of nominated students to the HSB.
The nominations should include:
 - full name of student: first name(s) and family name(s),
 - email address,
 - field of study at the home institution,
 - subject area at HSB,
 - exchange period at HSB: one or two semester(s).
- 4) HSB sends an email to the coordinators at the home institutions and/or the students with a link to HSB's online application form. The application period is:
 - For the fall/winter semester 2023/24: **01.03.2023 - 30.06.2023**
 - For the spring/summer semester 2024: **01.11.2023 - 31.01.2024**
- 5) The students receive an acceptance letter and admittance information after they have submitted their complete online application and have been accepted by HSB.
