Passport/Visa requirements Residency Requirements	<u>Passport/Visa requirements</u> If you are a non-EU national wishing to visit or travel within the EU, you will need a passport: • valid for at least 3 months after the date you intend to leave the EU country you are visiting, • which was issued within the previous 10 years, and possibly a visa. Apply for a visa from the consulate or embassy of the country you are visiting. If your visa is from a "Schengen area" country, it automatically allows you to travel to the other Schengen countries as well. If you have a valid residence permit from one of those Schengen countries, it is equivalent to a visa. You may need a national visa to visit non-Schengen countries. <u>Residency requirements:</u> Once in Ávila, all students no matter their nationality will have to apply for a Residency Permit at an Ávila Police Station.
Medical Insurance	All students must have a medical policy that insures them the whole time that they are in Spain.
