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Nomination & Application Procedure

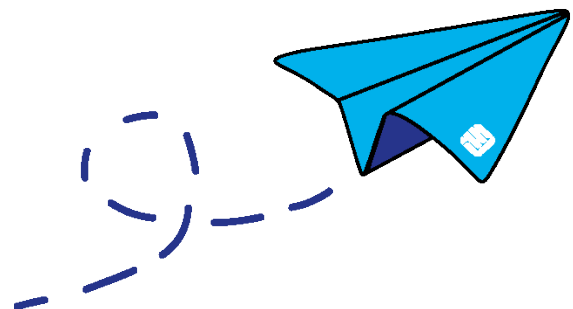

Nomination deadline	15 April	15 October
Application deadline	15 May	15 November

Please note that these **semester dates** also include the examination periods and that the actual start of lectures may vary from one department to another.

Please **nominate** your students within the mentioned deadlines via the link above.

Students will be informed about the **application** procedure soon after the end of the nomination deadline.





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Application Process & Letter of Acceptance

Shortly after the nomination deadline, all students will receive instructions on the application process, including information on course offerings.

During the application, students must submit a recent Transcript of Records, English and/or German language certificate, signed Application Form, and (Online) Learning Agreement/ Study Plan.

Please find an overview of our language requirements [↗ here](#). Although German usually is the main language of instruction in most departments, there are also multiple English-taught classes.

Students will receive a Letter of Acceptance shortly after their application documents have been reviewed and approved by the respective FH Münster departmental coordinator.

Requirements for Enrollment

Semester Fee

Upon enrollment, all students in Germany are required to pay a semester fee as a social contribution; this is not a tuition fee. Benefits for students include a semester ticket (granting free local public transportation throughout the whole of Germany), reduced cafeteria prices, discounted cultural and sports activities, and a library/copy card. The fee amounts to around 380 Euros per semester (as of Winter Semester 2026/27). [↗ More](#)

Health Insurance

All FH Münster students must provide proof of sufficient health insurance for enrollment. Students should contact their insurer before arriving in Germany. [↗ More](#)

Passport or identity card

Students must present valid identification, such as a passport or national ID card.



Orientation Weeks and Social Program

Orientation weeks organized by the individual departments are generally mandatory. In addition, the International Office hosts a Welcome Meeting to provide all essential information about the exchange. Some departments also offer dedicated buddy programs.

Throughout the semester, the FH International Reception Service Team (FHiRST) at FH Münster supports international students in settling in and adapting to student life in Münster and Steinfurt. The team provides guidance before and during their stay and organizes numerous social activities, including joint trips to major cities such as Berlin or Cologne. ECTS & Transcript of Records

FH Münster uses the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), with a regular full-time semester comprising 30 ECTS.

Students will receive an official Transcript of Records after the end of the exchange period by the respective FH Münster departmental examination office.

Language Courses

German language courses at various levels are offered free of charge to FH Münster students. Further details are available ➤ [here](#) and will be sent directly to students before the coming semester.

Accommodation

FH Münster does not offer on-campus housing directly. However, FH Münster has a special cooperation with Studierendenwerk Münster, a non-profit organization for student affairs that manages several student housing facilities in Münster and in the city of Steinfurt. International exchange students are offered housing on a priority basis within this contingent. Application details are provided after the end of the nomination process. Costs range between 320 Euros and 450 Euros depending on size and furnishing, plus a security deposit.
