- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

## F. Information

## 1. Grading systems of the institutions

UAIC uses ECTS for transfer and accumulation. The ECTS credit is a notional, averaged unit of 28 hours of student workload for passing a course (contact hours, any form of individual study). Each degree curriculum has 30 ECTS per semester; each course having 5 ECTS at Bachelor level or between 6-10 ECTS at Master level. Each department individually establishes the number of course credits based on its weight regarding the standard workload students need in order to achieve the expected learning results. Credits are awarded only if the student fulfils all the requirements necessary

GRADES: The Romanian grading scale runs from 1 to 10 and the marks have the following meanings: 1-4 fail, 5-6 sufficient, 7 satisfactory, 8 good, 9 very good, 10 excellent, Recommended ECTS grades: 1-4 = F, 5-6 = E, 7 = D, 8 = C, 9 = B, 10 = A.

P stands for Participation, i.e. the student has successfully and regularly attended the course.
