Course Catalogue	The lists of the courses might be offered by a department is available at <u>www.bologna.yildiz.edu.tr</u> Students must utilize the catalogue only for basic information about the courses such as codes, credits, and contents; they must not rely on the catalogue for the language of instruction and the semester information that the course is offered. Finding a course in the catalogue does not mean that the course will be available at the time of the mobility. The available courses are announced on OBS (Student Information System) just before the courses start. Therefore, students may need to make changes on their provisional programme upon arrival.
Thesis Study	Students planning to do research/thesis study at YTU should find supervising professor/mentor at YTU before they complete their Erasmus application. Students must ensure that the department they are planning to apply for is offering the intended type of research course/study. The students can contact the departmental coordinators to ask for assistance in finding a suitable supervisor. As soon as they have found a supervising professor, students should inform the Erasmus office by email: incoming@yildiz.edu.tr

Assessment	Assessment procedure for each course are usually described and documented in the first lecture. Assessments vary from class to class. Erasmus students are assessed in the same way as all other students on the same course. That is, they must sit examinations and complete the tasks set by the academic department offering the course.
Attendance	Regular and punctual class attendance is compulsory. Students may receive a failing grade due to absence.
